

**Articulation/Transfer Agreement
Between
Delta College
And
Central Michigan University
Honors Program**

This agreement is designed to facilitate the transition of students from Delta College (Delta) to the Honors Program at Central Michigan University (CMU). This agreement applies to students who transfer to CMU with an associate's degree or with 56 or more semester credits or with the MACRAO agreement but does not guarantee acceptance into CMU or the CMU Honors Program. Delta transfer students must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.5 at Delta or be a Delta College Honors Certificate recipient to apply to the CMU Honors Program.

- (1) Delta College and CMU will maintain the integrity of their separate programs and enter into this agreement as cooperating institutions.
- (2) Delta transfer students, upon application to and acceptance to the CMU Honors Program, must complete at least 11 credits of Honors coursework before graduation from CMU, of which 9 credits must be taken at the 300 level or above. Honors coursework is defined as HON classes, H-designated classes, and Honors contracts successfully completed. Honors Contracts may be used to fulfill a maximum of **3** of these 11 credits, with the approval of the Honors Director.
- (3) Students must complete a minimum of 3-4 credit hours of a single foreign language at the college or university level (retroactive credit hours in foreign language awarded through placement examination do not apply), or an alternative as approved by the Honors Program Director. A foreign language course taken at another accredited college or university can be used to satisfy this requirement.
- (4) Delta transfer students will complete 60 hours of volunteer community service during the student's two years at CMU.
- (5) Delta transfer students will complete a senior research project and/or creative endeavor at CMU and enroll in HON 499. Note: HON 499 is in addition to the 11 credits of Honors Coursework required above in number 2.
- (6) The requirements herein will be reviewed and revised (if necessary to revise) by both Delta and CMU:

The academic signatories of this agreement and and/or their departmental designees shall maintain at least annual contact with each other and will communicate to each other (and to the articulation office at their home institution) any curricular or other changes which may affect the accuracy/integrity of this basic agreement.

- (7) This update/renewal document is effective immediately and shall remain in effect until such time as either party wishes to terminate; notice of termination shall be given in writing at least one year prior to the effective date of termination. Qualified students applying to CMU during or after the semester of the update/renewal shall be considered under this agreement.
- (8) CMU and Delta agree to jointly share data to assess program effectiveness and adhere to the precepts of the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
